Checkout Policies



- Students will check out during their regularly scheduled library classes, and at other times when their teacher brings them in or sends them down.
- Students in grades 3-6 may check out an unlimited number of books as long as they are being reasonable and responsible.
- Students in grades K-2 have a set number of books based on their grade level.
- Students have free choice during checkout.
- Overdue notices will be sent home every other week.
- If a student damages or loses a book, they are expected to pay for it or replace it.
