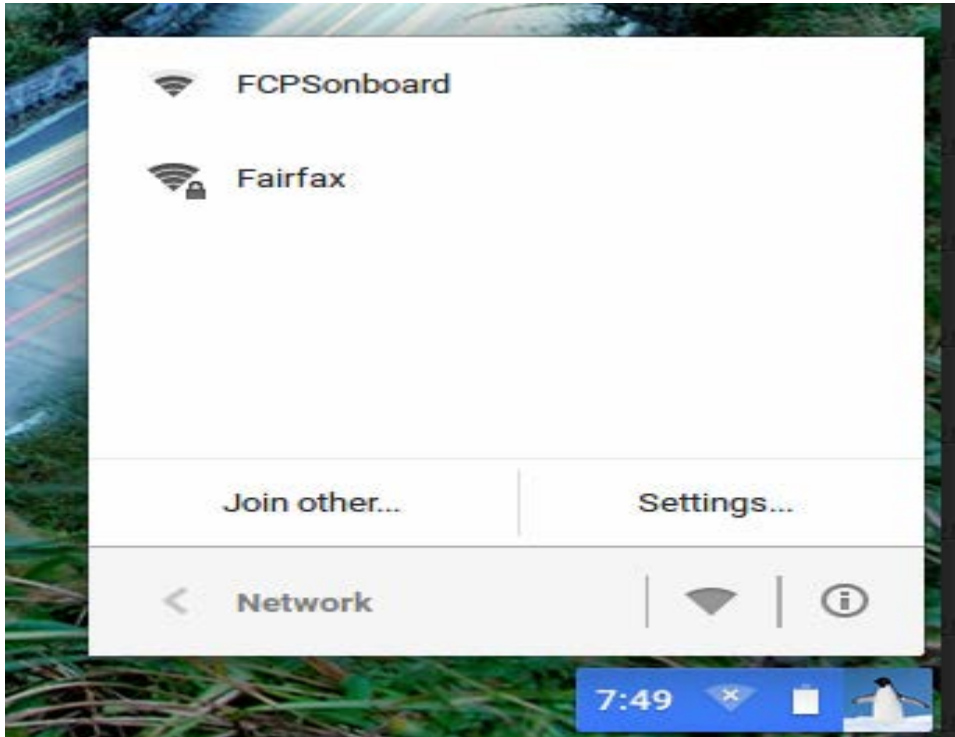


Chromebook Configuration

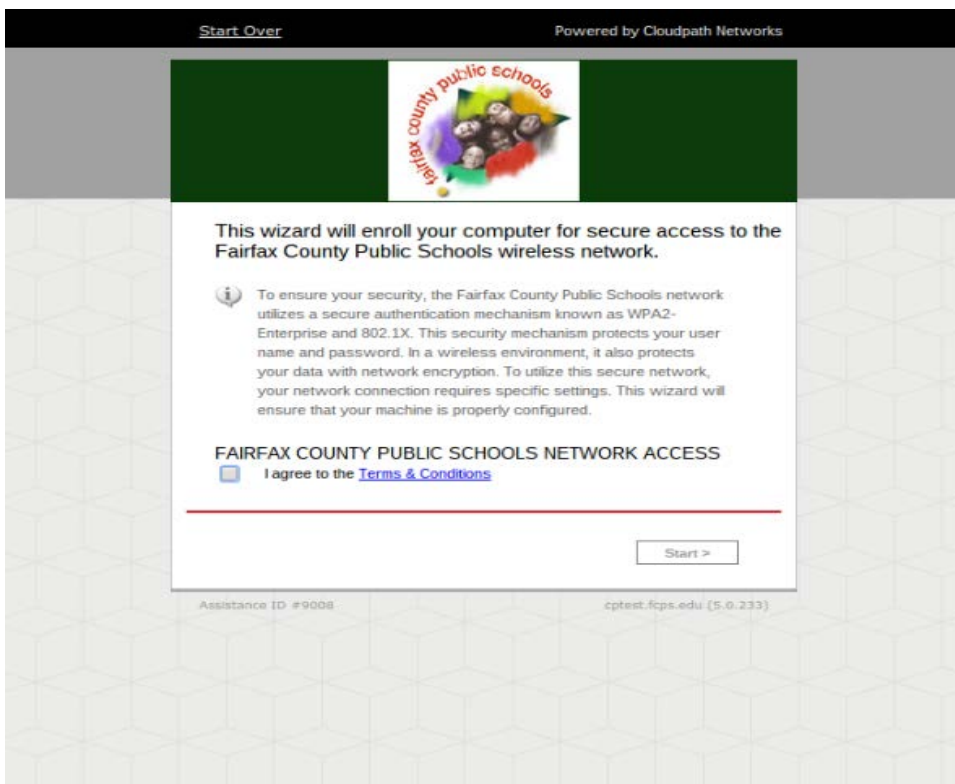

Secure Wireless



(Note: Chromebook must be logged in as user and not guest account to configure the wireless)

On your device go to the wireless icon in the lower right corner and choose the network FCPSonboard. Once it has connected open the Chrome Browser on the device.

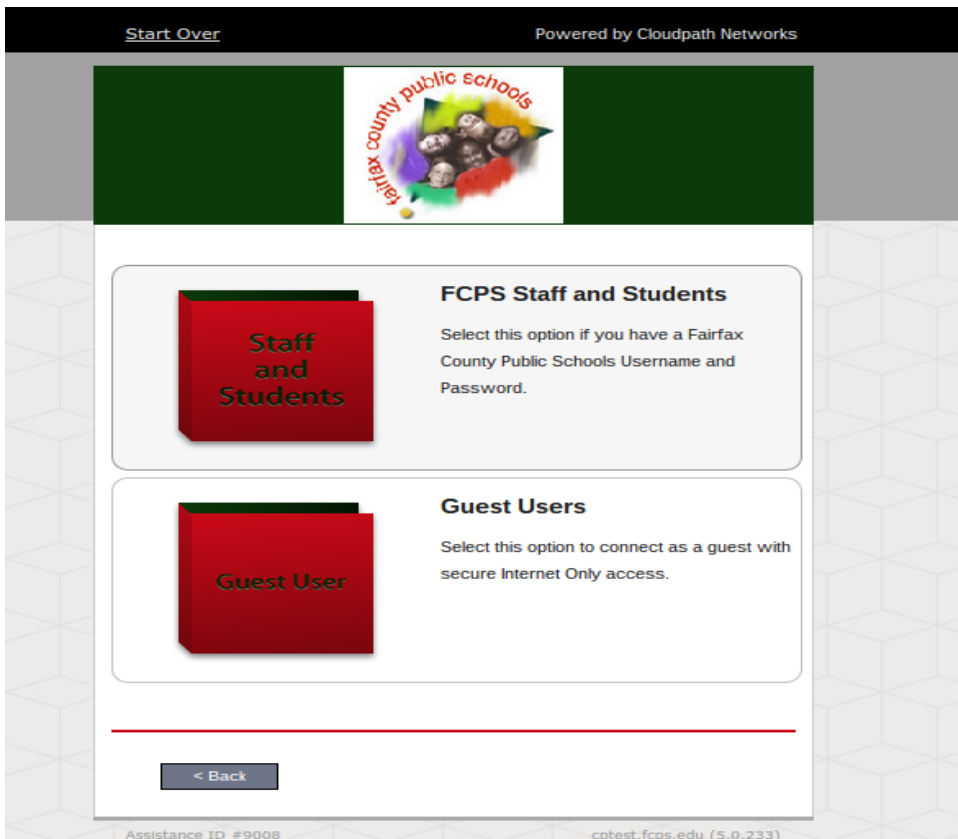


Once Chrome has opened, browse to a website.

Example: www.msn.com
www.cnn.com

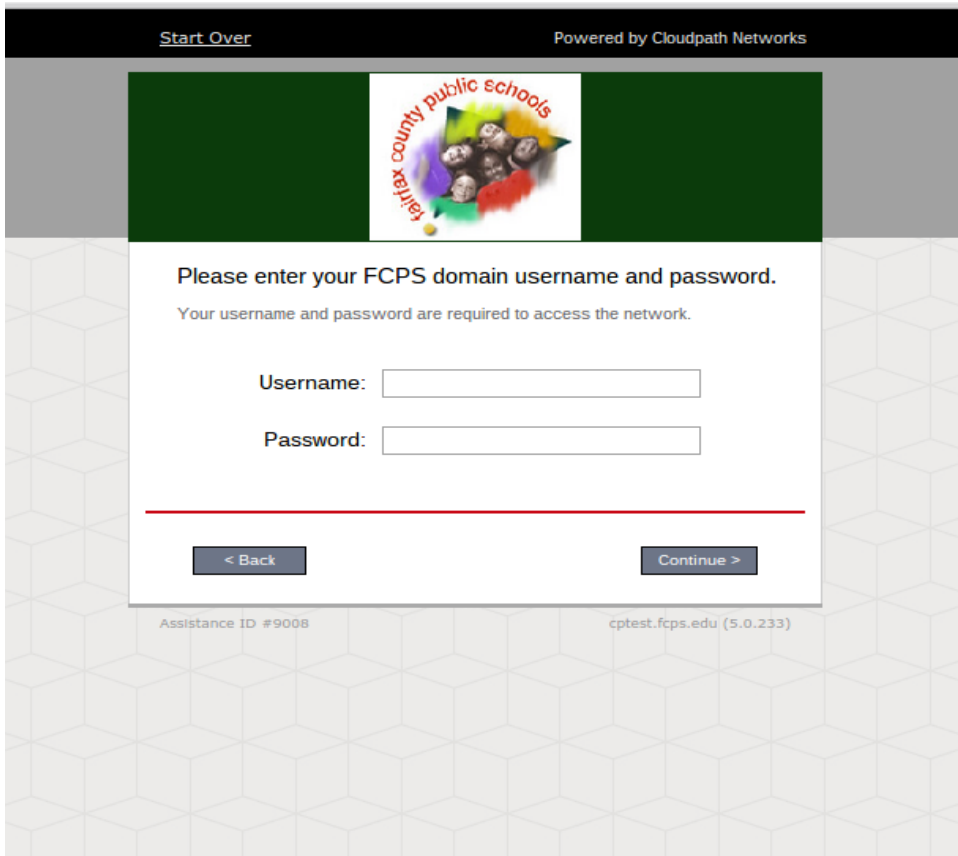
When you try to go to a website the system will redirect you to the onboarding configuration webpage.

Check the box to agree to the Terms and Conditions and then click **Start**.



Select FCPS Staff and Students to use your Fairfax County Public Schools username and password for secure access on the wireless network

If you do not have a FCPS username, you can select Guest User and you will be configured for Internet only access to the network.



Type in your username (Note: Put your username only, system will populate the domain)

Type in your password and click **Continue**

Guest User selection will not get this prompt.

Chrome OS

- If you are not logged in as the Chromebook owner, log out and log back in as the owner.



Step 1: Download the Network File

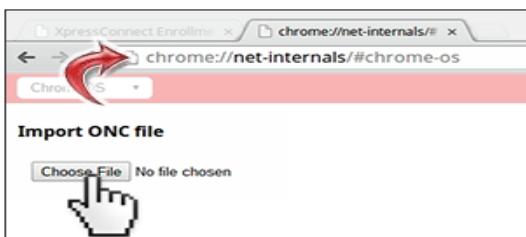
Simply download the file. Do not open it yet.



Step 2: Import Network File

Import the Downloaded ONC File.

- Open a new tab in the browser.
- Type (or copy & paste) this address into the browser:
chrome://net-internals/#chromeos



- Under **Import ONC File**, click **Choose File**
- Select the downloaded **Fairfax.onc** file and click **Open**.
- If an error is not reported, your device is now configured for the network.
- **To connect, select 'Fairfax' from the list of wireless networks.**

(Note: Device must be logged in as user and not guest account to configure the wireless)

The system will display instructions to configure your device. Step 1 is to download the Network file for your device. Click on the download icon next to Step 1.

Chrome OS

- If you are not logged in as the Chromebook owner, log out and log back in as the owner.

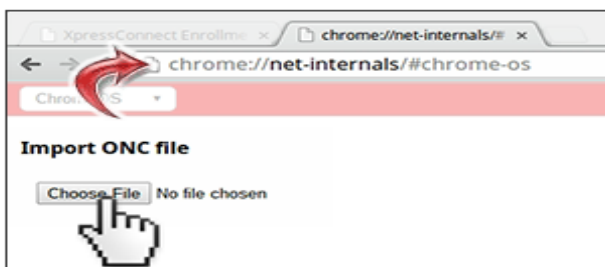

Step 2: Import Network File

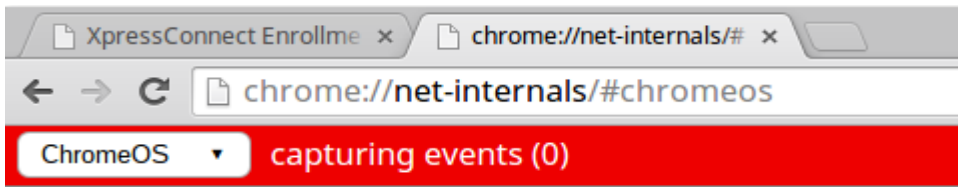
Import the Downloaded ONC File.

- Open a new tab in the browser.

- If an error is not reported, your device is now configured for the network.
- **To connect, select 'Fairfax' from the list of wireless**

Step 2 in configuration is to open a new tab in the chrome browser and Type (or copy and paste using Ctrl-C, Ctrl-V) the address highlighted in screenshot to the left.

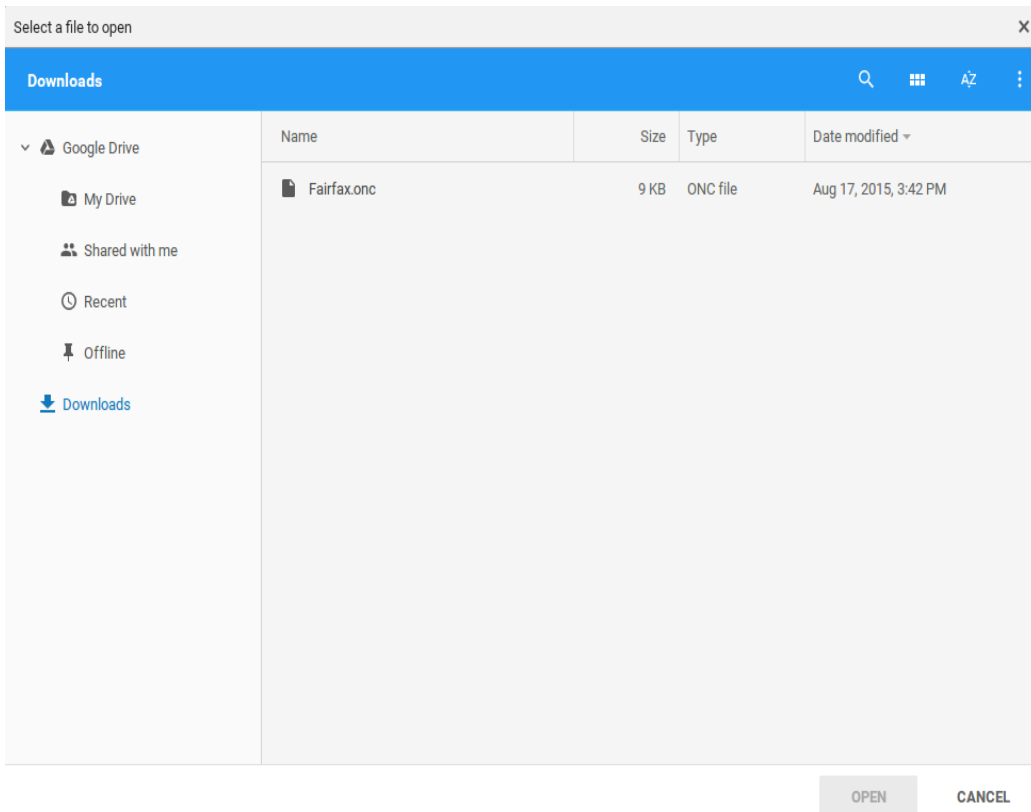

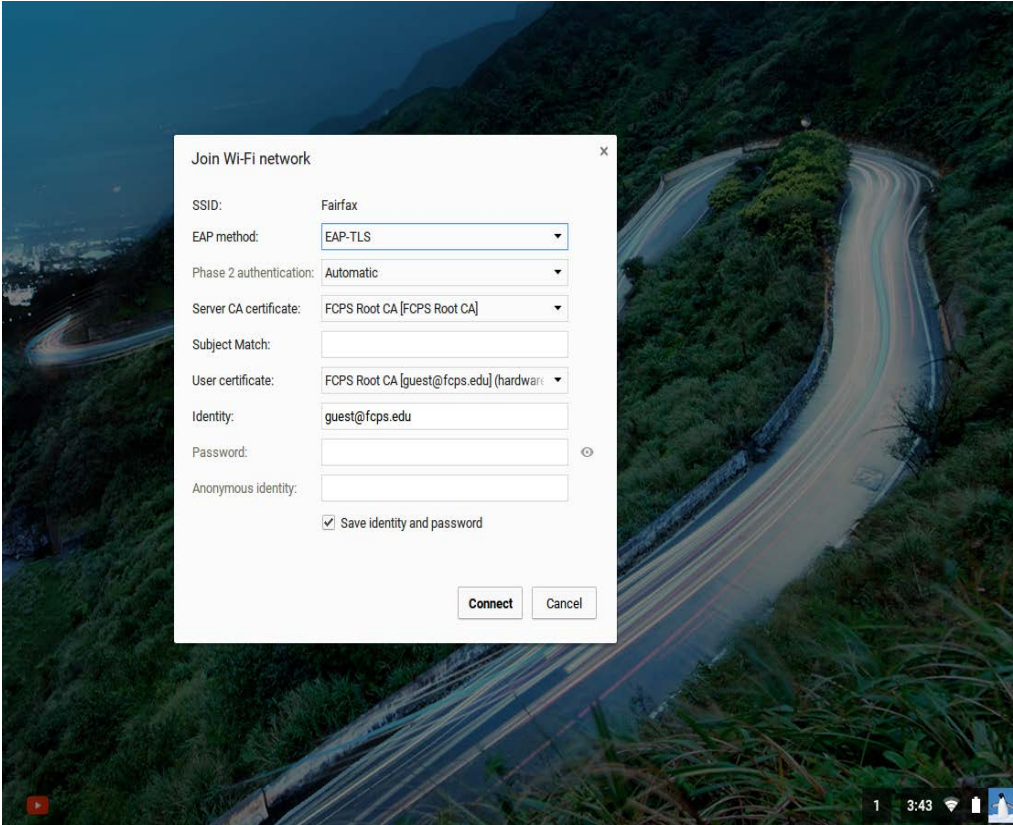
Select interface for debugging

When address opens the screen on left will appear. Under Import ONC file click **Choose File**



A Window will open to select a file to open. Click on file that was downloaded named Fairfax.onc and open. If no error is reported the device has been configured.



Go to the wireless icon in lower right corner and select network “Fairfax”. A box similar to display on the left will appear showing the certificates and identity for the configuration. (Guest enrollment in this case)

Click **Connect** at the bottom of window and network should connect to “Fairfax” network after 10-15 seconds.
