The purpose of this document is to outline the steps of using the FCPSonboard wireless network to correctly configure your device to connect to the Fairfax network.

Go to a web page such as www.cnn.com. If the wizard does not open, look to see if the site you entered is a https:// site rather than a http:// site. The device will only redirect to the wizard using a http:// site. The FCPSonboard wizard will come up on the screen. Check the box next to I agree to the Terms and Conditions and click the Start button.
Click the FCPS Staff and Students button.
Enter the username and password that you use to log on to the computer at school. Click the Continue button. NOTE: if authentication fails the account may be locked out, or the password may be expired

<u>NOTE:</u> If OS X is set to only trust applications downloaded from the Mac App Store follow these steps to by-pass the restriction.

Open the Downloads folder. Then Control-click on the XpressConnect.app file and choose Open. This will run XpressConnect.

You will then get prompt stating that XpressConnect.app is not from the Mac App store. Click Open to run the application. You will then be able to proceed with the onboarding process.
