



BEHAVIOR

To build genuine, mindful, and consistent behavior we will focus on the teaching and modeling behaviors that promote success. We will also focus on our language, the 3 R's: <u>Reinforcing, Reminding, and Redirecting</u>

<u>REINFORCING LANGUAGE</u> is concrete, specific, descriptive Example: Everyone lined up quietly and quickly when the bell rang.

REMINDING LANGUAGE is proactive or reactive, establishes clear expectations, maybe a question or a statement, and brief. Example: Remember, we are silent in the hallways. Show me what that looks like.

REDIRECTING LANGUAGE is response to off track behavior, direct, specific, and names the desired behavior. Example: Pick up that paper. Throw it in the trash can.

COMMUNICATION
